 - ❖ Verify savings according to commissioning plan

- Technical Study – Reimbursement of the study’s cost
 - ✓ Application – Scope of Work – see attached
 - ❖ Scope of Work from qualified auditor
 - ❖ Submit Application including qualifications and auditor documentation

 - ❖ Itemize each recommendation into an Energy Conservation Measure (ECM) table
 - ✓ Reimbursement
 - ❖ Submit Reimbursement Application
 - ❖ Attach study report with summary of recommended measures
